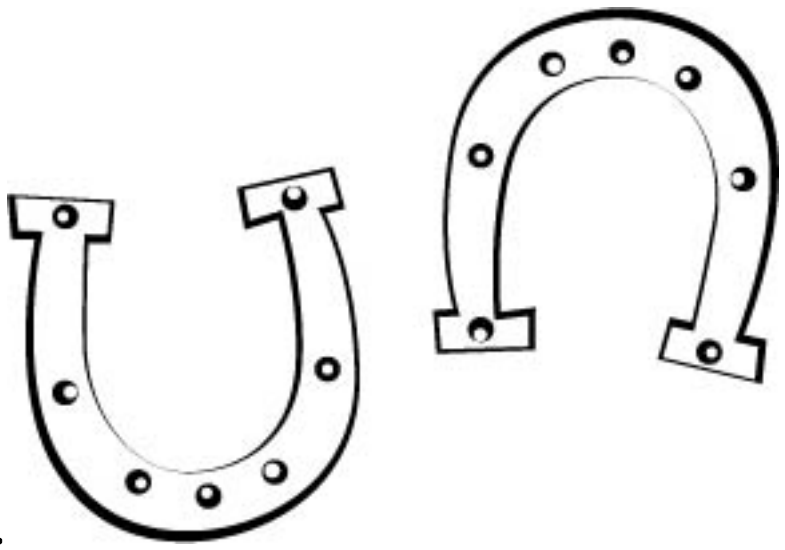
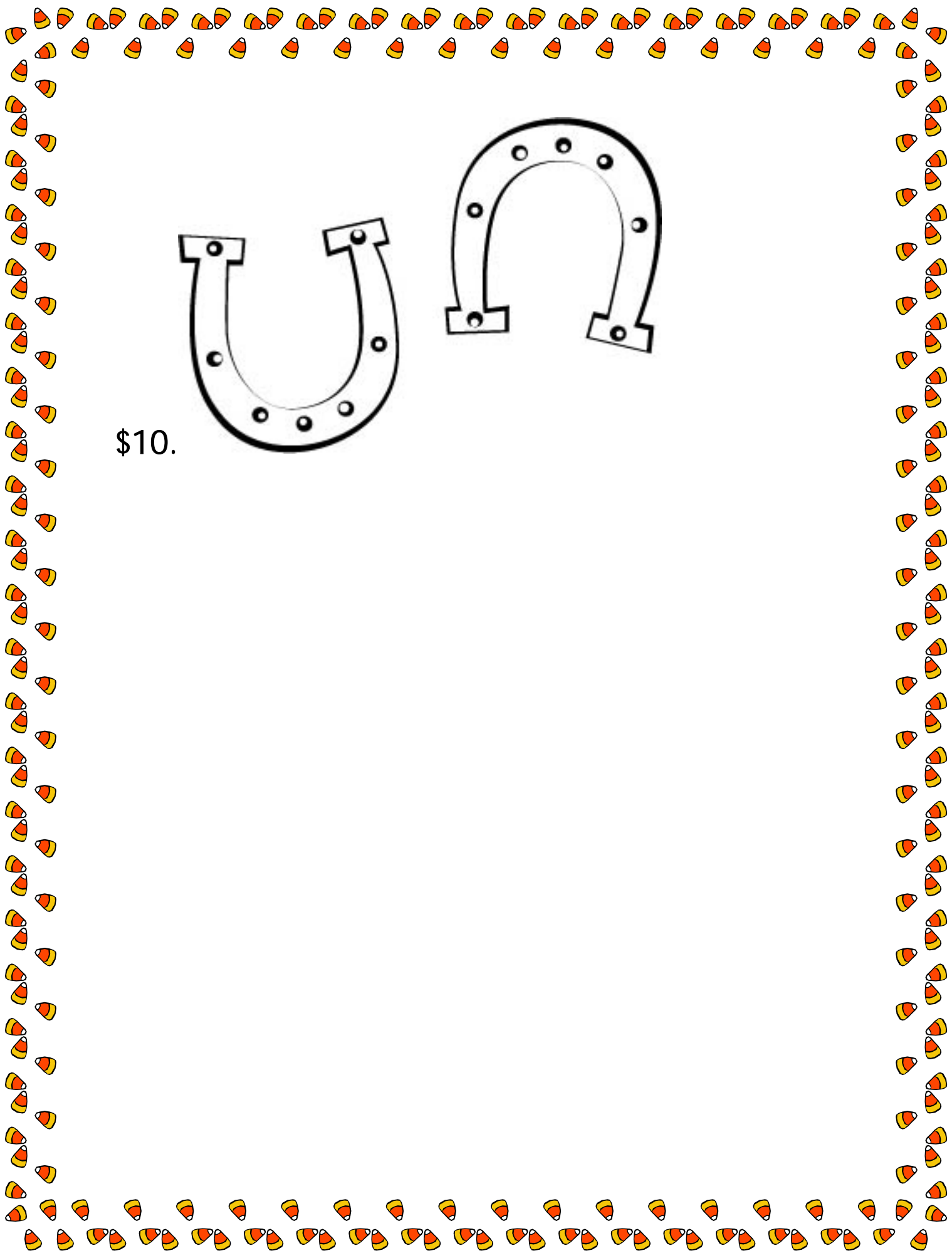


New Horizons Upcoming Schedule
