NEW MASS SCHEDULE beginning September 6th/7th will be 5:30pm on Saturday and 7:15am, 9:00 and 11:00am on Sunday. We will STILL be in the PARISH CENTER for this weekend. The 3pm Dedication Mass fulfills your Mass

obligation. There will be one collection at the Dedication Mass. Please put both regular envelopes and your building envelopes in the same collection for this Mass only.

WEEKDAY MASSES will begin in our Daily Mass Chapel on the birthday of Mary, September 8th. The daily mass chapel will hold 70 people on the main floor, and the balcony can be used for overflow.

RECONCILIATION- Our new church has a reconciliation Room off of the Daily Mass Chapel in the same location as it was in the old church. Confessions can either be face-to-face or behind the screen. The time will remain the same: 4:15-5:15 on Saturday's. There is a light on the door. Green means "open for business" and Red means it is occupied.

DEDICATION DAY PARKING- We will be reserving the parking lot next to the new church for the handicapped and elderly only. We will also have offsite parking with a shuttle bus service to the church. The shuttle will be available from 1:45 to 2:45pm and again after the Dedication Mass. Signs will be posted for these parking spots.

ONCE OUR NEW CHURCH OPENS, it is common for outsiders to want to see the Church. We would like to train a group of volunteers (docents) to call upon to give people a tour of the Church upon request.
