PARISH NURSE NOTES: Calcium and Vitamin D - Most women realize that they need calcium to protect their bones from osteoporosis but do they know that they need Vitamin D? Vitamin D is calcium's partner. It is essential for the proper absorption of the calcium. As we get older, our ability to synthesize Vitamin D from sunlight is diminished. We need to get it through supplements or food, especially in the winter. The recommended dose of Vitamin D for those who are 50-70 is 400 IU per day. Over 70, people need 600 IU per day. Men should not ignore their calcium needs as well. 20% of osteoporosis sufferers are men. The daily recommended dose for women and men over 50 is 1200mg. per day. Some good sources of dietary calcium are all milk products, including yogurt, canned salmon, broccoli, fortified juices and cereals. For example an 8oz. glass of milk has 300 mg, a ½ cup of spinach has 122 mg and ¼ cup of almonds has 95mg. Fortified cereal will have the Vitamin D as well. Read your labels and you'll be surprised.
